
Ceramics - Sculpture Select Graphic Design

Three-Dimensional Work





If work needs a stand, it must be provided.



Make sure any dust or debris is cleared from the work.



Place felt or cork pads on the bottom of work to provide stability and to keep the work from being damaged, or damaging the Museum's pedestals.

Cork pads




Two-Dimensional Work



All works should be mounted in some form to be hung on the wall. This might be:


- Affixed to black board
- Mated
- Mated and Framed








When mating your work, Museum standard is a 4 inch mat, and while this is preferred, it is not required. A minimum of 1 inch mat is required.






4 inch mat

Choose mating that is neutral. Try to match the color of your paper, if possible. This will allow the matting to "disappear" and not draw attention away from your work. Black mating is acceptable.
